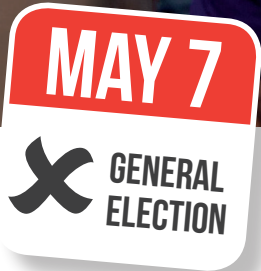

PUBLIC NHS

WE WILL:

- ✓ Fight for a publicly funded, publicly provided health service free at the point of use.
- ✓ End the creeping privatisation of the NHS and repeal the Health and Social Care Act 2012.
- ✓ Make mental health a much higher priority with resources to match this status.



FAIR ECONOMY

WE WILL:

- ✓ End austerity and restore the public sector, creating over one million good jobs that pay at least a living wage.
- ✓ Pay for this with a new wealth tax on the top 1%, a Robin Hood Tax on the banks and the closure of tax loopholes.
- ✓ Increase the minimum wage to reach a living wage of £10 an hour by 2020.



DECENT HOMES

WE WILL:

- ✓ Abolish the cruel and unfair bedroom tax.
- ✓ Build 500,000 new social rented homes and bring empty homes back into use to ensure everyone has access to an affordable place to live.
- ✓ Cap rent and introduce longer tenancies to provide greater protection for renters.

- ✓ Take serious action on climate change by working with other countries to ensure global temperatures do not rise beyond 2 degrees.
- ✓ Phase out fossil-fuel based energy generation and nuclear power.
- ✓ Invest in a public programme of renewable generation, flood defences and building insulation.

- ✓ Scrap university tuition fees - removing a financial barrier that is unfairly preventing many young people from reaching higher education.
- ✓ Promote a comprehensive system of local schools offering mixed ability teaching staffed by quality teachers.
